- Enrolled (Bachelor or Master) student with background in Economics, Data Science, Statistics, Geography, or related areas
- Good or very good grades
- Interest in the field of development economics, political economy, industrial policies and innovation economics
- Able to work independently and perform his/her tasks accurately and in a structured way
- Team spirit and flexibility
- Knowledge of statistics/econometrics
- Solid experience of data management in Python and statistical software packages (Stata) are required
- Experience with developing and maintaining Python scripts for automated web scraping from various sources as well as interest in Large Language Models are highly desired
- Fluency in English is required; knowledge of other languages (including German) is desirable but not needed
