Course Overview

- Study of the Eastern Mediterranean (Levant basin), characterized by high temperatures, salinity, and nutrient-poor waters.
- Rapid climatic and biodiversity changes, and significant bioinvasion from various regions.
- Anthropogenic pressures combined with natural oceanographic changes.
- Ideal model for studying oligotrophic environments under climate change and human influence.



Program Structure

10 Days of Intensive Study, including:

- Lectures by leading scientists.
- Hands-on research in wet and dry labs.
- Field excursions to various ecosystems.
- Tours of active research labs in Israel.
- Immersive experiences in Ashkelon, Beersheva, Haifa, and Eilat.
